

# DEATH AFTER CURE: THE PERILS OF SURVIVING TB IN UGANDA

Dr. Baluku is a research scientist with the Makerere University Lung Institute and the head of the Division of Pulmonology at Kiruddu National Referral Hospital in Kampala, Uganda. He is the immediate past general secretary of the Association of Physicians of Uganda. His research interests are in tuberculosis (TB) survivorship, HIV, TB/HIV co-infection, other respiratory infections, and the overlap of TB and non-communicable diseases in sub-Saharan Africa. As such he has authored more than 100 peer-reviewed publications. Dr. Baluku is a journal editor at PLOS Global Public Health and a guest editor for special collections on rare infectious diseases. He also serves on the Scientific Committee of the Union World Conference on Lung Health. His current research work explores epigenetic mechanisms underlying post-TB disease states, neurocognitive impairment and cardiometabolic profiles of TB survivors in Uganda.
