Dr. Larry S. Schlesinger is the President and CEO of Texas Biomedical Research Institute in San Antonio, TX, where he has led a transformational growth and scientific innovation process since 2017. As a physician-scientist, his research focuses on lung immune responses in tuberculosis and other infectious diseases, developing new therapies for these conditions. With over 250 peer-reviewed publications, Dr. Schlesinger has been funded by the NIH and other agencies for over 30 years and has trained ~175 individuals. He is a Fellow of the AAAS, IDSA, AAP, and AAM, and a past NIH NIAID Council member.
